

How to Zoom into your web browser on your computer (Internet Explorer, Chrome, Edge, Firefox, and other Windows Based)

1) Hold CTRL and press the + key to zoom in. Hold CTRL and press the - key to zoom out.

You can zoom in and out multiple levels.

2) If you prefer, the Zoom command is usually also available in the browser's menu.

- In Firefox, click the three horizontal lines at the top right and then click the + and - beside Zoom.
- In Chrome or Edge, click the three dots at the top right and then click the + and - beside Zoom.
- In Internet Explorer, hold ALT to get the menu bar to appear, then click View, followed by Zoom.

3) Using the mouse with a wheel: Hold CTRL and scroll the mouse wheel (the wheel in between the left and right buttons) forward to zoom in and backward to zoom out.

4) If you have a trackpad, put two fingers on the pad and pinch in (drag the fingers together) to zoom in or pinch out (spread the fingers) to zoom out. Most mobile devices also work this way

How to Zoom into your web browser on your Mac

1) Hold the command key (⌘) and press the + key to zoom in. Hold the command key (⌘) and press the – key to zoom out
